2016 Cherry Cove Pinot Noir

The ruby color of this wine suggests classic Pinot as the nose opens with fresh lavender and plum jam. Across the palate are vibrant tones, from explosive red cherry on entry to the lush strawberry on the lively mid-palate. Lingering floral tones hang for just a moment and carry through the soft finish.

About us

Initially planted in 1991, Coleman Vineyard family estate winery is located in the McMinnville AVA Coast Range foothills of the Willamette Valley.

Terroir

Coleman Vineyard is located in the McMinnville foothills of Yamhill County in the Willamette Valley. The vineyard is close to the Van Duzer corridor, an opening through the Coast Range mountains to the Oregon coast, providing hot summer days with afternoon winds cooling the evening temperatures significantly. We believe this temperature variation, along with the volcanic soils, contribute to the phenolic characteristics and brightness of the wine, providing a structure for aging and signature dark cherry and spice flavors with intense color. Because of these unique influences, the coastal foothills of McMinnville has been approved for AVA status, and the area is known as the McMinnville AVA. The area is 40 million years old, formed from oceanic volcanic uprisings followed by deposits of lava from the Cascade Mountain volcanic eruptions known as 'basalt tufts'.

Recommendation

This wine is best enjoyed from an Oregon Pinot Noir or other large-bowled wine glass that will allow the wine to fully express the bright fruits, Bing cherries, and damson plums that are layered with sage and thyme. This medium bodied pinot noir is both a sipper and a meal enhancer with its rich tannins and lengthy finish. Perfectly delicious with Myanmar pork curry, pepperoni pizza, pasta w/traditional tomato sauce, rice bowl with lentils, nachos, or bbq anything.
